When Jim and Nancy Demetriades purchased the historical property, it was in need of some TLC, so they began a renovation project, completing stage one in 2009 and stage two in 2013. Improvements include the addition of one-, two- and three-bedroom chalets, upgraded fireplace suites, updated bedrooms, the new day spa and the kids' Cub Club area.
